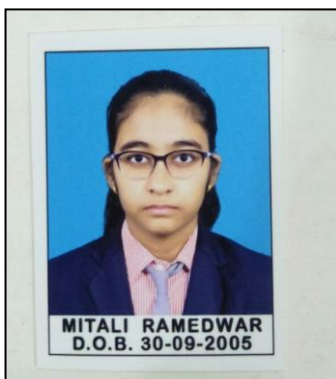

Millions of people around the world, of all ages, suffer from blindness and visual impairment. There are an estimated 8 million blind people in India as of the year 2020, according to estimates from World Health Organization.

The white cane, smart cane, smart glasses, and other assistive devices that are available are designed specifically to help people with visual impairments, but they all share a serious flaw. They are all unidirectional. These devices' unidirectional nature presents a number of difficulties, including limited task scope, limited information, and limited awareness.

This pilot model aims to fix that serious flaw. Our working prototype has four sensors – one on each arm, one on the chest, and one on the back – which enables a person to navigate much more easily and have spatial awareness of all four directions.

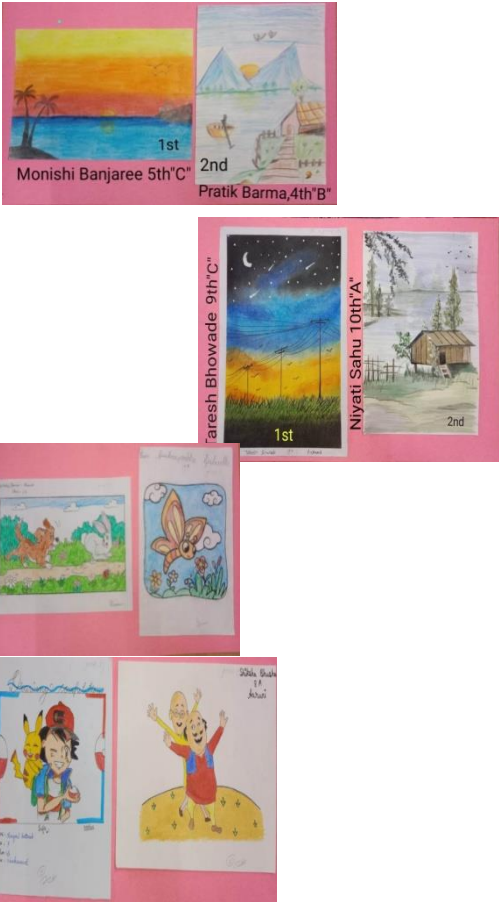
